ABOUT RCLweb

"*RCL* is a **highly selective core list of almost 60,000 titles** in all subjects. It includes both **books** (monographs, series, reference works, in some cases textbooks) and **electronic resources** (CD-ROM and subscription databases, web sites and other internet-based resources). *RCL* describes an **ideal core collection** for the library of a hypothetical college or small university that concentrates on the traditional liberal arts and sciences curriculum but also offers undergraduate-level courses (although not necessarily majors) in business, computer science, education, engineering, and the health sciences. Even small liberal arts colleges will have at least twice the number of titles in the *RCL* database, the additional ones chosen to support their individual curricula and student and faculty interest. The titles suggested by *RCL* should be the ones all academic libraries must have; almost all these should be titles which can be profitably read and used by undergraduates, at least by the more advanced students." CHOICE Review:	To date, the majority of HIV/AIDS research has concentrated on education and prevention for those with a seronegative status, and studies of HIV positive individuals have been concerned with the potential to infect others. In this book, however, Green (Univ. of Essex, UK) and Soboo (Children's Hospital, San Diego) focus on how the discovery of an HIV-positive status affects the individual's sense of identity and on the experience of living with HIV and its effects on the individual's social relationships. A wide range of people were interviewed in the studies presented and to understand better their accounts of living with HIV, the authors employ an analytic framework and perspective that connects individuals, through daily interactions and experiences in their communities of origin and attachment, to the society in which they live. Drawing upon the concepts of stigma, dangerous identities, and health risk, the authors describe the reevaluation that people with HIV and AIDS must make of the risks entailed by everyday social interactions, and examine their negotiation of these interactions. Using a combined UK/US perspective, Green and Soboo explore identity change and the stigma attached to an HIV-positive status.
